**Cleaning potential outbreak of Norovirus**



- 1 Wash hands with antibacterial soap and water then sanitise with alcohol gel hand rub.
- 2 Use appropriate PPE as indicated in the Safety Data Sheet.
- 3 Blot affected area with an absorbent material, then pour on a solution of CHLORINE TABLETS diluted 435ppm (1 tablet per 2.3 litres warm water). Leave for 15 minutes.
- 4 Place all waste in waste bag. Seal bag and place in appropriate area for disposal.



- 5 Disinfect again with a solution of chlorine tablets diluted 1,000ppm (1 tablet per 1 litre warm water). Again leave for 30 minutes or longer if possible then wipe with a disposable cloth.
- 6 Place all waste in waste bag. Seal bag and place in appropriate area for disposal.
- 7 Dispose of solution after each use/day.
- 8 Wash hands with antibacterial soap and water then sanitise with alcohol gel hand rub.
- 9 Remove safety signs.
